he Parish Council held its regular meeting on June 3. In addition the Parish Council held a joint meeting with the executive officers of the Ladies Society and Men's

Forum. The executive officers and representatives of ACYO, Sunday School, Saturday School and Hokejash Committees were invited but were unable to attend.

The purpose of the joint meeting was to open a dialogue between the Parish Council and the organizations to identify ways that we can help each other during our transition period between parish priests so that activities in the parish will continue without any interruption. I am pleased to report that both the Ladies Society and the Men's Forum have their normal full calendar of events planned for the balance of this year and the Ladies Society has noticed an increase in participation in their events. I would like to thank Jackie Manoogian and Gary Markarian, respective chairs of their organizations, and members of their executive boards for stepping up to the plate and doing a great job.

This issue of the Dajar has been traditionally published for the combined months of July and August. We will continue that tradition and the next Dajar will be published for the month of September. I have received a few comments regarding the cover of the Dajar pointing out that it still bears the name of our former parish priest. We have 27,000 pre-printed covers on hand and plan to use them up rather than incur the cost at this time to reprint them only to have them reprinted again when we have a new priest.

I am pleased to report that your Parish Council has agreed that St. Paul will host the Centennial Commemoration of the Armenian Genocide. It will be held on April 24, 2015 and the planning committee is expecting a very large attendance and community involvement.

In my first article as Parish Council Chairman I reported that one of our challenges would be to bring

financial stability back to our Parish. To that end, we have reviewed the expenses and made cuts where feasible. I am confident that there is no wasteful spending in our Parish. Further, we have projected our income and expense for the balance of the year and have determined that our expenses will be more than our income resulting in another deficit year.

Our income from membership dues and stewardship donations needs to increase to cover our anticipated shortfall. With under 200 dues paying members in our Parish, it is impossible to cover our budgeted expenses with just the minimum dues. All of us have to embrace the reality that to keep our church vibrant and active we need to make a financial commitment annually in excess of our minimum dues. That's how we will stay strong. Many of our parishioners are following this path. And yes, we do understand that some parishioners are donating at their limit for which we are grateful and have no further expectations. But for those that are able, now is the time to hear the call from our church. If you are able to increase your stewardship it will be an immense help.

By now you should have received our letter and accompanying Pledge Form. I am aware that the pledge form for 2014 should have been in your hands before the beginning of 2014, but it just didn't happen. We have taken this delay as an opportunity to redesign the pledge form to make it clear and easy for you to calculate your annual dues and determine at what level you can participate in stewardship. Many of you have paid your dues and stewardship already and this form may be unnecessary. For you, this will be an opportunity to preview the form for 2015 before it is distributed at the end of this year. For those of you who haven't fulfilled your 2014 dues and stewardship, you may use this form.

This is a sobering message this month; one that I hope not to repeat. However, it is my obligation to keep you fully informed about our church. Thank you for taking the time to read it and hopefully respond positively.






